Articulation Criteria and Articulation Benefits

1. ***The standard articulation criteria (“Articulation Criteria”) are:***
 - a. Completion of an Associate Degree.
 - b. Achieving a minimum overall cumulative grade point average of 2.0.
 - c. Submission of an official College transcript.
 - d. Fulfillment of residence requirements for the bachelor’s of mortuary science at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science. The requirement for the degree is completion of a minimum sixty-two (62) credit hours of coursework at CCMS. Credit earned by means of transfer courses does not count toward residence.
 - e. Courses for which the student is eligible to receive transfer credit will be based upon the articulation agreement in place the term the student is admitted to the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science.

2. ***The articulation benefits (“Articulation Benefits”) are:***
 - a. Facilitate transfer of courses between the College, ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE, and Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science, BACHELORS OF MORTUARY SCIENCE, (see Appendix 1).
 - b. Benefitting Northeast Ohio by infusing the job market with qualified graduates.
 - c. Students with 3.0 GPA will be eligible to apply for Cincinnati College of Mortuary scholarships.
 - d. A student who completes all of the associate degree requirements in ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE at Belmont College (see Appendix 1) will be admitted into CCMS BACHELOR’S OF MORTUARY SCIENCE program with junior status (see Appendix 2).
