No matter the undergraduate nursing credential you have earned as a Registered Nurse (RN), Herzing University offers a pathway for you to earn a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN). Our RN to MSN degree options are tailored for registered nurses with an associate degree (ADN/ASN/AASN) in nursing looking for the shortest path to earning an MSN:

- **Accelerated RN to MSN path** for RNs seeking the shortest route to an MSN
- **RN to BSN to MSN track** for RNs who also want to earn a BSN on their way to earning an MSN

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING – ACCELERATED RN-MSN

With Herzing University's online MSN programs, you can pursue the degree you need to advance your career in a specialized nursing role. Choose from 4 concentrations to specialize in family practice as a Family Nurse Practitioner (MSN-FNP), administer to mental health needs as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (MSN-PMHNP), train the next generation of nurses as a nurse educator (MSN-NE), or prepare for management roles as a nursing leader or administrator (MSN-NLA).

- How long? 28-32 total months on average, depending on concentration

- Choose your MSN concentration: Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP), Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP), Nursing Education (NE) or Nursing Leadership and Administration (NLA)

Accelerated RN to MSN

Bridge directly from an ADN to MSN in the Herzing Accelerated RN to MSN program.

- Curriculum built to accelerate your MSN completion
- How long? As few as 20-24 months, depending on concentration
- Ideal for nurses who are not required by their employer to hold a BSN
- Choose your MSN concentration: Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP), Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP), Nursing Education (NE) or Nursing Leadership and Administration (NLA)

The HERZING Difference

▶ MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING—ACCELERATED RN-MSN

The average length of time for a student taking a full course load is 20 months when transferring in an applicable nursing or associate degree.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Enrollment requirements are consistent regardless of your concentration or whether you choose the accelerated RN to MSN or RN to BSN to MSN track. Prerequisites include:

- Live in a state where Herzing University is authorized to offer the RN to MSN program
- Hold a current, active and unrestricted license as a registered nurse (RN) in the same state in which they practice
- Hold an associate degree (ADN/ASN/AASN) or diploma in nursing from a nationally or regionally accredited college or university
- Participate in an interview to identify your goals and if the RN to MSN will work for you

POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATES

Once you've earned your MSN degree, you may choose to continue your lifelong learning to enroll in one of our post-master's certificate programs including a Family Nurse Practitioner or the Nurse Educator Program.
